Last year the CFL awarded 17 grants to nonprofits for services and programs such as child services, bikes for children, meals and food pantries, shelter services, kids summer camp, and abuse & drug awareness.

The review committee will consider these categories for funding: Documentation of Need, Cost Effective, Impact on Community, Resources Available, and Budget.

Grants submitted after January 31st at 5 P.M. will not be considered.
